Priority of Access Guidelines

Please read the following information about priority of access to childcare. The Australian Government priority of access guidelines must be applied when parents are applying for a limited number of vacant places. The guidelines outlined in the Australian Government's Child Care Service Handbook set out the following three levels of priority, which child care services must follow when filling vacant places:

- **Priority 1:** a child at risk of serious abuse of neglect
- **Priority 2:** a child of a single parent who satisfies, or of parents who both satisfy the work, training, study test.
- **Priority 3:** any other child.

Within these main categories, priority should also be given to the following children:

- Children in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander families
- Children in families which include a disabled person
- Children in families which include an individual whose adjusted taxable income does not exceed the lower income threshold or who or whose partner are on income support
- Children in families with an non-English speaking background
- Children in socially isolated families
- Children of single parent
